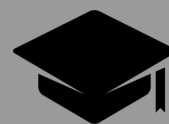
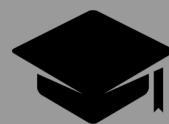

Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools will be launching the School Messenger SMS (Short Message Service – Text Messaging) system to deliver important messages to parents. Some of you may already be receiving emails from the school via School Messenger and the next step will be to implement the SMS Text Messaging. We will use the School Messenger SMS to inform you about important events, school closures, safety alerts and as a means to communicate in the event of an emergency.

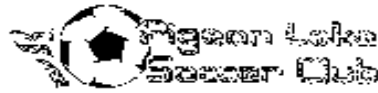

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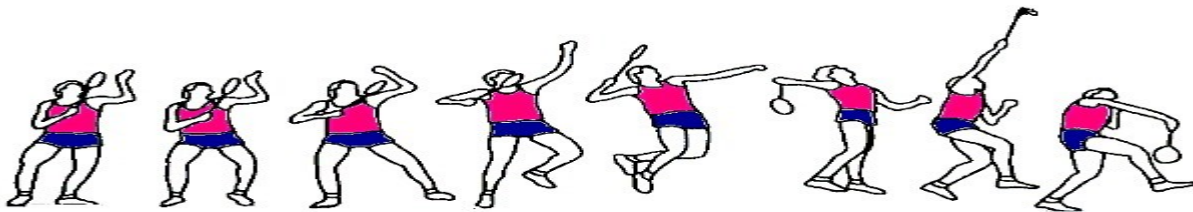
Junior High Badminton
